**Day 4** Visit Atigar Mosque, Apakhoja Tombs, renowned Sunday Bazaar, Handicraft Street, Old Town **Kashgar**



**Day 5** Day trip to Karakul Lake, view glaciers of 7500m mts Muztaghata and Kongur, **Kashgar**

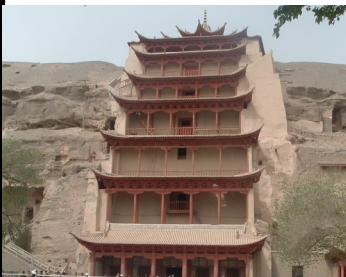
**Day 6** Fly Urumqi a.m., Provincial Museum, Bazaar, evening show, **Urumqi**

**Day 7** Visit Heavenly Lake, local Kasak family, **Urumqi**

**Day 8** Travel to Turpan, visit Jiaohe ruins, Karez underground irrigation system **Turpan**

**Day 9** Visit Gaochang ruins, Bezeklik Thousand Buddha Caves, Flame Mountain and Astana Graves. **Overnight train** to Dunhuang

**Day 10** Visit Sand mountain, Crescent Lake, camel ride, stay in **Dunhuang**



**Day 11** Visit Mogao Buddhist grottoes, carpet factory, relax in **Dunhuang**

**Day 12** Travel by bus to **Jiayuguan**, the western end of the Great Wall.

**Day 13** Visit Jiayuguan Fort, Great Wall Museum, travel to **Zhangye**

**Day 14** Visit Sleeping Buddha, Marco Polo statue, travel to Shandan, Rewi Alley museum and tomb **Shandan**, **NZCFS 60th and Shandan Bailie School 70th Birthday Party in evening.**

**Day 15** NZCFS project coop, Big Buddha, Rewi Alley tomb, museum, SBS, **Shandan**



**Day 16** Travel to Lanzhou, visit Rewi Alley Square, dine with He Mingqing scholars. **Lanzhou**

**Day 17** By train to **Baoji**

**Day 18** By bus to Fengxian (Shuangshipu), visit Rewi Alley cave house, NZCFS projects, meet project partners Fengxian Women's Federation, **Fengxian**

**Day 19** By bus return through Baoji via NZCFS project coop to **Xi'an**

**Day 20** Terracotta Warriors, Banpo Neolithic village, day tour **Xi'an**

**Day 21** Xian city wall, Big Goose Pagoda, meet Shaanxi Women's Federation, evening take soft sleeper train to Baoding. **On Train**

**Day 22** Visit Kathleen Hall's Songjiazhuang village, Norman Bethune mausoleum **Baoding**

**Day 23** By bus to Beijing via Wolf Tooth Mountain. **Beijing**
