Symposium on China Studies, Beijing July 23-25; Hangzhou July 26-28 Report,

Twenty five sinologists from 22 countries attended this annual symposium along with a number of Chinese academics, this being the tenth year. The audience included a large delegation of international students participating in a 3 month course on international relations at Beijing University. Many of the questions to speakers came from this group.

I was privileged to be invited, and presented a paper titled "[Understanding Chinese Culture: the challenge to the west](#)". [Link here](#). Overall some very positive messages about China's emerging role in global governance came from all speakers, in an environment of open and frank discussion. In Hangzhou, the highlight was to visit Alibaba centre, to learn the development of the company, its vision for the future of global commerce and exchange, and the new digital technology and infrastructure
