To promote friendship, understanding and goodwill between the peoples of China and New Zealand by encouraging visits and exchange of ideas, information, culture and trade between the two countries.

To foster interest in and promote the study of China, its history, culture, political and social structures - past and present.

To support specific aid projects in China.

To promote the study of the Chinese language by New Zealanders and advanced English studies in this country by Chinese people.

To foster on-going development of all sister-city links between New Zealand and China.

To assist visiting students and new immigrants from China requiring help to adjust to New Zealand society.

Special Projects:

The Shandan Bailie School. Founded by Rewi Alley in a remote town in Gansu province. NZCFS sends NZ teachers, equipment and other support to help it serve the local community.

The Gung Ho Co-operative Movement. Also founded by Rewi Alley. NZCFS helps it promote co-operatives throughout China.

The He Ming Qing (Kathleen Hall) Memorial Scholarships. NZCFS funds three-year scholarships that support young Chinese from poor rural areas to complete nursing training.

Poverty Alleviation Projects. NZCFS works with Women's Federation and other partners to support rural development in several western provinces of China.
