**Guest Speaker: Li Tao**

**Speaking on the Film-Making Experience Between Two Cultures**



Filmmaker Li Tao moved from South China to Wellington with her family in 1999. In Wellington she finished a feature documentary film about the cross-cultural life of young Chinese international students. *Waves: The Diaries of Chinese International Students in New Zealand* ("Waves") had more than 20 screenings across NZ as part of the 2006 International Film Festival. Since 2007, it has been used by the Ministry of Education as a teaching resource for all secondary schools in New Zealand.

Li Tao was invited back to Shanghai to teach Film Studies at Fudan University, Shanghai Institute of Visual Arts. In Shanghai she finished the documentary series *Shanghai in Cinema* as the writer and co-director. Li Tao has also completed a feature film script *Gap Year Romance* as a China-NZ screen co-production project. She has also spent more than ten years digging out her family stories to complete a family epic documentary *Returning Home* (2020 NZFC documentary film development fund project). *Returning Home* reflects the lives of ordinary Chinese people within the changing culture and society of China over the past 50 years.

At this monthly meeting, Li Tao will share her film-making experience between the two cultures China and New Zealand. We will also screen short excerpts from her feature documentary film *Waves* and her film in progress *Returning Home*.

Our monthly meetings are held at **Newtown School Hall**.

## NEW ZEALAND CHINESE LANGUAGE WEEK

Our committee members took the challenge of #5days5phrases and here are our chosen phrases.

Branch President, Chris Lipscombe, shared the famous quote from Chairman Mao: 好好学习天天向上 (hǎo hǎo xué xí tiān tiān xiàng shàng) translated as "Study hard, every day improve". Chris says this is a reminder that worthwhile goals are worth striving for, and learning the Chinese language requires constant effort — climbing the mountain without a top!





Our Vice President, Juping Zhou, chose this phrase 春暖花开 (chūn nuǎn huā kāi), translated as “during the warmth of spring all the flowers bloom”. Spring is a good season to enjoy the blooming flowers and the New Zealand Chinese Language Week.


The favourite phrase of Branch Secretary, Vera Xu, is 红红火火恍恍惚惚 (hóng hóng huǒ huǒ huǎng huǎng hū hū), loosely translated as “prosperous in a trance”.



红红火火恍恍惚惚

This is an internet catchphrase from the pinyin input method on a computer keyboard or mobile phone. When you enter ‘hhhhhhh’ as shorthand for ‘laughing out loud’ 哈哈哈哈哈

哈 (hā hā hā hā hā hā hā), the phrase that appears is 红红火火恍恍惚惚 (hóng hóng huǒ huǒ huǎng huǎng hū hū). Vera likes this phrase as it is funny, kind of nonsensical, and it also suggests happiness.




Our committee member, Liqin Mi, recommends this phrase “言必信，行必果” (yán bì xìn, xíng bì guǒ). This is a popular saying by the Confucius, meaning promises must be kept and action must be resolute.

“举头望明月，低头思故乡” (jǔ tóu wàng míng yuè, dī tóu sī gù xiāng) is the last phrase we chose. It is the second part of the poem 静夜思 (jìng yè sī) "Contemplation of Moonlight" by Li Bai, a famous poet from Tang Dynasty. Please see below for a translation of the whole poem:

Before my bed  
There is bright-lit moonlight  
So that it seems  
Like frost on the ground.

Lifting my head  
I watch the bright moon;  
Lowering my head  
I dream that I'm home.
